Dear DFA employees,

As we continue to navigate a period of significant change, I want to ensure that we remain connected, informed, and supported. Last week, we shared difficult <u>news</u> regarding staffing reductions within DFA, and I know this has raised concerns and uncertainty across our community. Please know that these decisions were not made lightly and reflect the ongoing need to align our resources with our financial realities.

Given these circumstances, we have made the decision to <u>cancel</u> <u>the DFA Social</u> originally planned for June 4. Instead, we will host a virtual <u>town hall on June 4 from 10–11 a.m.</u>, creating an opportunity for open dialogue. We will provide further details, answer your questions, and discuss how we are adjusting our service levels. Please <u>submit any questions</u> you would like addressed by Friday, May 30, 2025.

Our decisions reflect broader financial challenges, influenced in part by evolving federal policies and budget considerations. I encourage you to stay informed through the <u>UC Federal Updates</u> and <u>Federal Updates for the UC Irvine Community</u> websites.

I also want to remind you that support is available. UCI's <u>Life</u> <u>Resources Program</u> is a free, voluntary, confidential employee assistance program that is available 24/7 in multiple formats.

We are committed to maintaining open communication and will continue to keep you updated as we navigate this transition. Thank you for your understanding and professionalism.

Continuous Improvement Focus: TDS: Automated Carpool Matching Service

Transportation & Distribution Services recently completed a <u>CPI project</u> that established an easily accessible no-cost carpool matching service for UCI affiliates, integrating OCTA's platform into UCI's transportation options. TDS: Automated Carpool Matching Service

?	Problem:	In order for carpooling to continue to grow as a sustainable commute option for UCI, providing an easily accessible, flexible and free of charge matching service is key. Such option didn't previously exist.
Ø	Goal:	 Establish a no-cost carpool matching service for UCI affiliates. Promote sustainable commuting by encouraging carpooling.
-`Ų́-	Solution:	The solution was implemented in December 2024 and involved integrating OCTA's platform into UCI's transportation options, featured on the TDS website.
¥¥¥¥	Result:	The project made no-cost carpool resources easily accessible. Ongoing monitoring tracks adoption rates and program impact.
